



### **Learning Enrichment**

When I arrived at Good Shepherd Lutheran College nearly seven years ago, mid-term in 2016, I decided to develop a vision for our Learning Enrichment Program.

It was to have a school where Inclusion was a part of the conversation for planning, programming and assessment. It was also to have people in the community talking of our school as a place that understood difference and acceptance of each other with our differences. This is very much in line with the International Baccalaureate Mission Statement.

Our Learning Enrichment teams wanted to grow their knowledge and embarked on a series of courses with Online Learning Training - a blended learning course involving Online and Face to Face training in many different disability areas. Our teaching staff also joined in on the courses offered and learnt with the



assistance of the Learning Support teachers at each campus to set up 'Initial Intervention Plans,' and 'Adjustments Profiles' for students.

As I walk around the school on my last days as the Learning Enrichment Coordinator, I can happily say that I see a culture that mirrors these wishes back to me. Our staff have our children with all of their differences at the heart of their planning, programming and assessment and the conversations in the staffrooms are often about ways to better cater through the use of Universal Design for Learning. Our programs, especially in the Enrichment Room centre around the needs of the child with a focus on regulation and wellbeing. We have also enjoyed our team work in Tournament of Minds competitions and the World Scholars Cup both at Charles Darwin Uni and here at Good Shepherd.

As the staff and students and families continue to grow this culture of inclusion, I am sad to be leaving. I personally want to thank the families, my Learning Enrichment staff, the school staff in general and the wonderful students for entrusting me with your precious time and shared dreams and plans. Good Shepherd will always have a piece of my heart.

Good Shepherd Lutheran College were also recipients of this year's Rowe Scientific

































































































